Allah – the creator of the world
 Prophet Mohammed – Allah’s chosen one
 Quran – a collection of sacred books
 Prayer – when someone talks to God
 Fasting – only eating between sunset and sunrise
 Ramadan – a time of fasting
 Imam- the leader of the Mosque
 Mecca/Makkah- a city in Saudi Arabia. It is the most holy place in the world for Muslims.
 Nasheed – similar to hymn
 Wudu – washing before prayers
