Worship – an act of religious devotion e.g. prayer
 Worship hymn - song of praise to God
 Congregation – members of the church
 Spiritual – feeling inside not connected to physical things
 Lord's Supper – sharing of bread and wine in remembrance of the Lord
 Holy Communion - Lord's Supper
 Community volunteer – somebody who freely gives their time to help the people in their area
