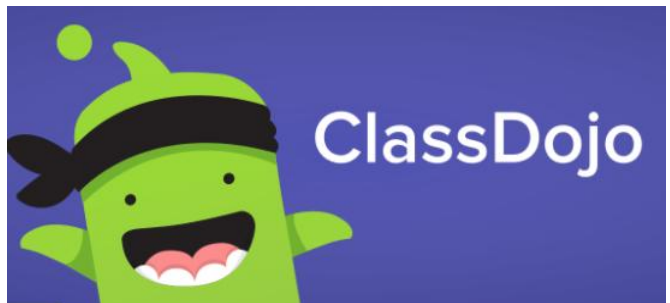


Welcome to Nursery

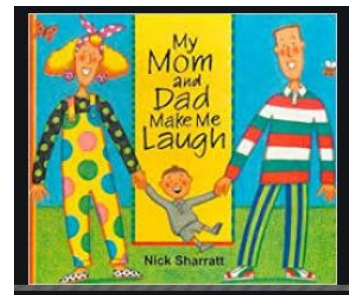
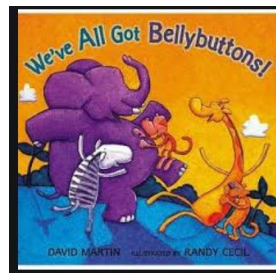
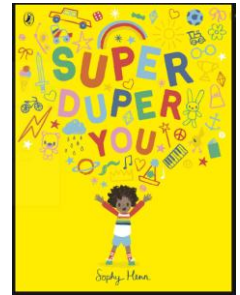
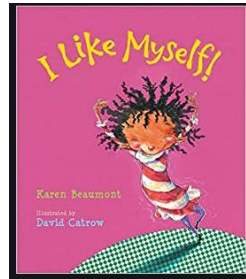
Books, books and more books
