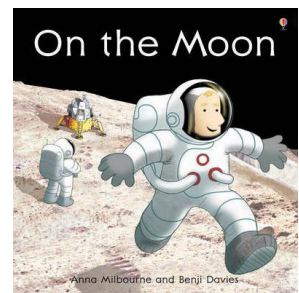
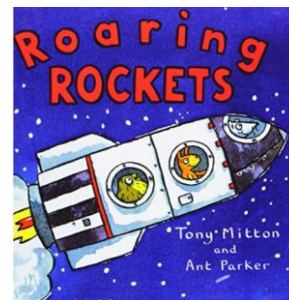
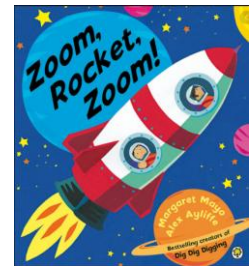
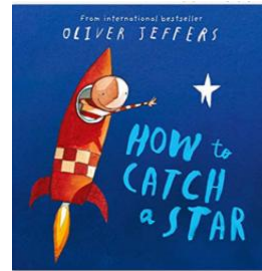
We love to use the interactive white board to play lots of fun, learning games.
