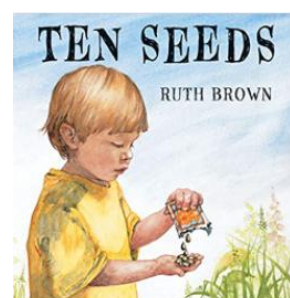
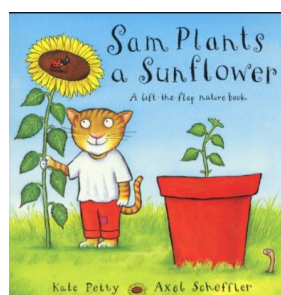
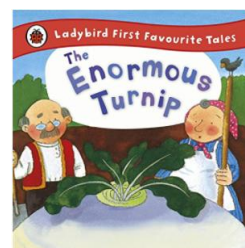
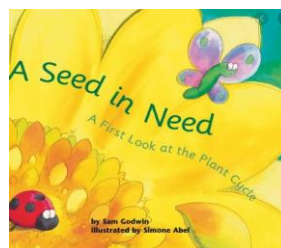


Why should children play outside?
